



OCCUPATIONAL CATEGORIES

The occupations are categorized according to these definitions:

CATEGORY 4A

Professionals whose jobs require little physical effort or movement (for example, a lawyer, a chartered accountant, a notary or a doctor) as well as certain executives or managers; high-level administrators and selected categories of white-collar workers can be included.

CATEGORY 3A

Professionals or technical staff not included in category 4A; clerical or technical employees within an acceptable industry, administrators or managers with jobs that demand a high degree of stability and responsibility. Occupations involving deliveries or manual labour are not eligible.

CATEGORY 2A

People in certain technical fields who supervise workers in technical trades that are not dangerous or who perform specialized clerical duties. Also included are certain people working in sales within an acceptable industry.

CATEGORY A

Skilled workers in industries or trades that are not dangerous, including certain office employees and sales staff.

CATEGORY B

Manual labourers whose jobs, generally in construction or in a factory, are more physically demanding.

CATEGORY OO (OTHER OCCUPATIONS)

All other occupations being refused or not classified in the categories mentioned above.

If an occupation is categorized as "**Other Occupations**", you can offer the monthly indemnity in case of accident or in case of sickness for salary insurance coverage as well as overhead expenses **available in our Blue Flex (Quebec) and Blue Vision (Ontario) products.**



OCCUPATIONAL CATEGORY RECLASSIFICATION

CONDITIONS

To be eligible for any occupational category reclassification, the Insured must meet the following conditions:

- 1) Work outside the home more than half the time;
- 2) Have at least three years of experience in the same role or five years of related experience**;
- 3) Exceed the following income requirements for the last two years:
 - a) \$35 000 for the following occupational category reclassification: from B to A or from A to 2A or 2A to 3A
 - b) \$60 000 for the following occupational category reclassification: from 3A to 4A;
 - c) \$115 000 for the following occupational category reclassification: from A to 3A or 2A to 4A.
