DISABILITY INSURANCE BLUE FLEX (FLEX PLAN) AND TANGIBLE

Proof of income is always required for:

- An insurance amount of \$3,500 or more
- The option to submit proof of income with the application, unless otherwise stipulated below

Educators working 100% of the time from home without certification (without completed studies in Early Childhood Education or accreditation recognized by a Home Childcare Coordinating Office) and having a minimum income of \$12,000 after expenses and before taxes	120 days	2 years
